Approve Final Payment for 2022 Sanitary Sewer Main Lining 22-06

BACKGROUND

- 2 On December 6, 2021, the City Council awarded the 2022 Sanitary Sewer Lining to Hydro-Klean,
- 3 LLC. Work completed under the contract totaled \$961,949.32. The work was successfully
- 4 completed, and the project is ready to be closed out.
- 5 The project is part of the City's sewer lining program, begun in 2006 to rehabilitate the sewer mains
- and extend the life of our sanitary sewers by 50 years or more. Lining technology essentially installs
- a new resin pipe inside the original clay tile sewer main without digging up city streets, which results
- 8 in minimal disruption to residents during construction. The liner pipe is inserted into the main
- 9 through existing manholes and cured-in-place with a heat process. Each segment is typically
- completed in one working day. Service line connections are reopened using a robotic cutter and
- remote cameras. During the process, existing flows are bypassed using pumps. This technology
- also prevents infiltration of groundwater into the main system and can be credited toward a
- Metropolitan Council Environmental Services inflow/infiltration surcharge.
- 14 City policy requires that the following items be completed to finalize a construction contract:
 - Certification from the City Engineer verifying that all of the work has been completed in accordance with plans and specifications. (See Attachment B)
 - A resolution by the City Council accepting the contract and beginning the one-year warranty as of January 31, 2023, when the work was substantially complete. (See Attachment A)

- 20 It is City policy to keep utility infrastructure in good operating condition, utilizing current
- 21 construction technologies that keep service disruption during construction to a minimum.

22 **BUDGET IMPACTS**

- The final contract amount, \$961,949.32, is \$35,949.52 (3.9%) more than the awarded amount of
- \$925,999.80. The higher amount is due to the addition of several lining areas.
- 25 This project was performed in cooperation with the City of Falcon Heights to include their sewer
- lining. The City of Falcon Heights will reimburse the City of Roseville in accordance with their
- 27 cooperative agreement.
- The 2022 Sanitary Sewer CIP budget of \$900,000 was identified for Roseville funding. The project
- came in under budget with a final cost of \$777,632.12 for the Roseville Sanitary Sewer fund. The

remaining costs for the project will be invoiced to Falcon Heights. The funding breakdown for the project is listed below:
