Item Description: Receive Update on Rice St./Larpenteur Ave. Multi-Jurisdictional
Visioning Plan

BACKGROUND

On July 27, 2016, the cities of Roseville, St. Paul, and Maplewood partnered with Ramsey County to host a dialogue with the community on how to revitalize and re-envision the Rice St. /Larpenteur Ave. corridor. The St. Paul Area Chamber of Commerce (SPACC) facilitated the discussion and consolidated community feedback. The July discussion was well attended and solidified the desire for visioning along the corridor.

Elected officials, along with staff representatives from each municipality, met with Ramsey County over the last year to discuss ways the cities might collaborate on revitalizing, reinvesting, and rejuvenating a corridor in need of attention and intervention. The planning group developed a Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit consulting services and on March 13 the City Council hired Perkins+Will to lead the visioning efforts. Lead Consultant, John Slack, is prepared to brief the City Council on efforts thus far, and to provide a tentative timeline for the project.

POLICY OBJECTIVE

The Roseville City Council adopted a Policy Priority Plan that included a focus on Southeast Roseville.
