Summer Entertainment Program modifications:

- Performance area under band shell, including pavement, will be protected with barriers for performer safety.
- Performers (non-family) will be spaced at least 6' apart, with a maximum of 22 performers.
- All personnel will be required to wear a mask and practice 6' social distancing while assisting with audience seating, performance area setup/takedown, and other interactive tasks.
- Performer schedule may change at any time, and last-minute cancellations may occur due to Covid-19.
- Performer lineups will be available only on the website (rather than paper flyers) at www.cityofroseville.com/liverog

Spectator Information:

- Potential audience members are asked check themselves and other household members for symptoms of Covid-19 before attending a performance.
- Eight foot circles will be painted six feet apart in the grassy seating area, one circle per household of up to six people.
- Park bench spacing allows for ONE PERSON or multiple people from ONE HOUSEHOLD per bench.
- Dancing will be allowed only in household seating areas, not on pavement near performers.
- Full audience capacity until further notice will be 250 people, as directed MN Dept. of Health. Once capacity is met, no additional participants will be allowed within amphitheatre. Concerts may be canceled at any time due to safety concerns.

Basic Cleaning Information:

- Park bathrooms are cleaned and sanitized once per day.
- Park benches are not cleaned or sanitized and should be used only at user's risk.

NOTE: All personnel (paid staff, volunteers, sound techs, and performers) will be required to check themselves for Covid symptoms before each performance, to use hand sanitizer/wipes upon arrival to the performance area, and to wear masks during setup and takedown.
