The following program time procedures will be followed.

- Each child/adult pair will have their own set of supplies.
- Supplies will be disinfected at the end of the class.
- All participants 5 and over are required to wear a face mask. Under 5 is encouraged.
- Require Kidcreate Studio and Roseville Parks and Recreation staff to wear a face mask.
- Disposable aprons will be used when possible.
- Child/adult pair will have assigned seats and table space to ensure social distancing.
- Maintain social distancing at all times.
- Masks may be removed when enjoying treats at designated table space. Participants must stay seated the entire time while having treats and masks must be put back on promptly when not eating and/or drinking.

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Arrival and Departure Information:

When arriving, please practice social distancing while waiting to be checked in and shown to assigned space. All pairs will have a designated table and chairs to stay in over the course of the program. Each table will be dismissed one at a time when leaving in order to ensure social distancing while exiting the space.

Spectator Information:

In order to keep a controlled and safe environment during the class as well as the amount of space in the room, we will not be allowing any additional spectators at the program.

Basic Cleaning Information:Disinfecting Protocol

The following disinfecting procedures will be followed.

- A hand sanitizing station will be set up with hand sanitizer.
- Disinfecting all hard surfaces before and after program.
- Disinfecting areas that are commonly touched such as door handles, cabinet handles, sink handles, toilet handles, light switches, soap and towel dispensers before and after program.
- Bathrooms and sinks available at all times.
