42		additional lots created. Staff responded that it is consistent with legal requirements.

44		Chair O'Brien questioned if there is any indication on how the neighbors feel about a park at
45		this location. Staff responded that specific outreach for this particular site has not been done
46		to assess interest or gather feelings.
47		
48		The Commission discussed the small size of a potential park versus a cash recommendation
49		that could be used towards improving parks or purchasing a larger park in the SW area. The
50		need to keep looking for opportunities in the SW area of Roseville was emphasized.
51		
52		Commissioner Stoner suggested a potential larger strategy for SW Roseville that would
53		combine smaller parcels in the future.
54		Commissioners Recommendation: Commissioner Bole moved to recommend to the City
55		Council that they accept the cash option in the amount of \$8,000 to satisfy the Park
56 57		Dedication requirement for the Midland Crest Development. Commissioner Hoag seconds.

59 60	4)	a) UPDATE ON CLEVELAND AVENUE AND MARION STREET PARK SITES
61		AND NAMES
62		The Commission was provided a list of community recommended names for the new parks
63		located at 2134 Cleveland Ave. and 1716 Marion Street.
64		located at 2134 Cieveland 11ve. and 1710 Marion Street.
65		The construction documents have been finalized. Much of the work on the parks will be
66		completed in house and also utilizing the community build approach. However, there are
67		some areas that will require a contractor. Bid documents have been sent out.
68		
69		It is anticipated that community involvement in appropriate areas for building the parks will
70		occur in September and October, 2018.
71		
72		Vice-Chair Baggenstoss asked for clarification if the Commission could choose a name
73		outside of the list of community recommendations. Also, he requested the names be added to
74		the Parks and Recreation website to allow the public access. Staff confirmed that the
75		Commission could recommend a name that had not been previously suggested and that the
76		list will be added to the website.
77		
78		Chair O'Brien encouraged Commissioners to come to the August meeting prepared for a
79		robust naming discussion. She also thanked those members of the Community who have
80		submitted names and encouraged the submittal of additional name suggestions.
