Minnesota Statute 412.831 requires cities to designate a legal newspaper annually for publication of ordinances and other notices. On January 7, 2019 the council designated the Roseville Review as the city's legal newspaper. On September 30th the city was informed that Lillie News has closed, the final publication was October 2nd. Bids will be solicited later in the year for the 2020 Legal Newspaper.

Staff requested quotes from the Pioneer Press and Star Tribune. Rates are as follows:

Pioneer Press \$6.00 per column inch for a one-time publication/\$5.50 per column inch for each

additional publication.

Star Tribune \$1.31 per line

From staff analysis, the Pioneer Press is more cost effective than the Star Tribune. It should be noted that the Pioneer Press costs are only slightly higher than the costs the City incurred with the Roseville Review.

17 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The 2019 budget includes funds for legal notices. The rates for publishing with either of the papers is greater than the Roseville Review.
