Item Description: Railroad Quiet Zone Study

Background:

In response to numerous historic calls about train horn noise within and around the City of Roseville, staff commissioned a consultant to study the twelve at grade railroad crossings within the City of Roseville to determine what would be necessary to upgrade the crossings to meet Federal Rail Administration (FRA) standards for a quiet zone, where train horns would not be necessary.

The resultant study is attached. Staff will provide a summary presentation at the meeting which will encompass the information in the first 44 pages of the report. The remaining pages are detailed crossing survey information for each crossing as well as the “Guide to the Quiet Zone Establishment Process” information guide from the FRA.
