Background

Some items of note:

- City Council meeting on May 10th will be discussing possible revisions to the Park Dedication Fee Ordinance.
- Purchasing Policy is going through the Racial equity tool kit and will go to Council in June.
- EDA approved entering into a purchase agreement with Genisys Credit Union for the Sale of the Fairview Fire station at their April 19, 2021 meeting. There is an initial due diligence period of 150 days. Closing will occur after that period.
- Public Works, Environment and Transportation (PWET) Commission discussed a water efficiency rebate program for efficiency improvements related to irrigation systems at their April 27th meeting.
- PWET Commission will be reviewing the results of the Recycling RFP at their May 27th meeting. If the Finance Commission wants to review these results and offer a recommendation to the City Council, we need to move the June 8th meeting to Thursday June 3rd as this item is going to the City Council on June 7th.
