Item Description: Consider Reappointment of Youth Commissioners to Various City Commissions and Declare Vacancies

BACKGROUND

It has been customary for the City Council to appoint non-voting youth representative(s) to serve on various advisory commissions.

The following Youth Commissioners' terms end August 31, 2021 and are seeking reappointment for a 1-year term ending August 31, 2022. Two of the previous youth commissioners that served on the Parks & Recreation Commission and the Public Works, Environment and Transportation Commission have aged out of eligibility for reappointment.

Below is a listing of existing youth commissioners seeking reappointment.

Chapter 201 (Advisory Commissions), section 201.03 of city code states that City Council may appoint up to two additional residents of the city who are the age of 18 or under and enrolled in high school to serve one-year terms on a commission as ex-officio youth commissioner. At this time, these are the only youth commissioners who are serving on an advisory commission and eligible for reappointment. The Council may choose to advertise for up to two (2) vacancies on any of the advisory commissions except the Police Civil Service which is governed by Minnesota Statutes 419.02.

REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTIONS

Reappoint Yiling (Beverly) Xie to serve as youth commissioner on the Human Rights, Inclusion and Engagement Commission for term ending August 31, 2022.

Reappoint Corbin Carlson to serve as youth commissioner on the Parks & Recreation Commission for term ending August 31, 2022.

Council may choose to also advertise for additional vacancies on the following commissions pending the decision on reappointment above.
