**BACKGROUND**

Minnesota State Statute 412.121, Acting Mayor, requires cities annually to designate an Acting Mayor among Councilmembers. The acting mayor shall perform the duties of the mayor during the disability or absence of the mayor, or in the case of a vacancy, until a successor has been appointed.

**412.121 ACTING MAYOR.**

At its first meeting each year the council shall choose an acting mayor from the council members. The acting mayor shall perform the duties of mayor during the disability or absence of the mayor from the city or, in case of vacancy in the office of mayor, until a successor has been appointed and qualifies.
