What is Dementia?

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- □ DEMENTIA is the general term for declines or deficits in cognitive abilities AND declines or deficits in daily functioning
- MILD COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT (MCI) refers to deficits in cognition WITHOUT deficits in daily functioning
- □ Dementia can be DUE TO various diseases
 - Alzheimer's Disease
 - Cerebrovascular Disease (strokes or mini strokes)
 - Lewy Body Disease
 - Parkinson's Disease

Neuropsychologists love patterns!



- Different patterns of test scores are associated with different conditions
- These pattern differences are associated with where the neuropathological changes occur in the brain, at the various stages of the disease
- Alzheimer's Dementia and Vascular Dementia have different patterns of strengths and weaknesses
- Alzheimer's Dementia and Lewy Body Dementia have different patterns of strengths and weaknesses

Measuring Hippocampal Function with Neuropsychological Tests

- Memory tests "tap into" the function of the hippocampi
 - G For example, learn a list of 12 words over 4 learning trials
 - Recall them after a 20 minute delay
 - Recognize those words amongst a list of target and distractor words
- Alzheimer's patients have difficulty recalling and recognizing the words because the information has not been retained (the file has not been saved)
- Vascular dementia patients have difficulty learning the words, recall some of what they got in, and recognize most of the words accurately (the file has been misplaced)
- Lewy Body dementia patients are disorganized with learning and recall, but recognize most of the words (file has been set aside)
