


Background

Constellation Concept




Parks and Facility Map



System Master Plan Identified Strategies

- ➤ Connectivity strategy Use existing Roseville parks and parks in neighboring communities by extending trails and sidewalks to better link residents to recreation opportunities.
- ➤ Small parcel strategy Identify small "vacant" parcels, typically less than 0.5 acres, to provide recreation opportunities.
- ➤ Large parcel strategy Identify larger parcels, typically more than an 1.0 acre, to provide recreation opportunities.
- ➤ Combination
