LEAGUE INFORMATION

Leagues are scheduled to begin on Monday, April 22. Leagues utilize USSSA Rules with minor modification (see official rulebook at Cityofroseville.com/softball). All bats must have the new USSSA bat stamp (excluding wooden bats).

Leagues will be played at Central Park Victoria; Central Park Lexington and BDale/Villa Ballfield in Roseville. All fields are fenced and groomed daily.

Games will be played between 6pm and 10pm. In the event of inclement weather, up to two weeks of weather cancelations will be made up. Make ups will be played at the end of the season on a team's scheduled night of play, or during a bye week.

The top 8 teams from each league will qualify for the league playoffs. Home run limits will be used in each league (see league rules for details).

All players are expected to behave in a sportsmanly manner and in accordance with USSSA rules and the Roseville Adult Sports code of conduct.

REFUNDS

Refunds requested through March 1 will be granted their league fee minus an administration refund. Refunds requested between March 1 and March 30 will receive a 50% refund. After March 30, no refunds will be granted.

RETURNING AND RESIDENT TEAMS

Resident teams must consist of 75% of team players or more that live in the City of Roseville. Resident teams that are new to the league may register for our leagues at the same time as returning teams.

All players must be at least 18 years of age and out of High School. Members of your team must also be in good standing with the MRP/USSSA sports organizations.

REGISTRATION DATES

January 17- Returning teams (teams who played in any Roseville 2018 softball league) & Roseville resident teams***

January 31- Registration opens for ALL teams

March 29- Registration closes

-Please note most leagues fill prior to closing date- entries are taken on a first come, first accepted basis

FULL PAYMENT DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

New teams that do not meet the resident requirement may register their team starting January 31, 2018.

FREE AGENTS

Roseville Parks and Recreation keeps a list of individual players who would like to be placed on a team. This list of players will be distributed to all team manager requesting additional players. To acquire this list prior to distribution of schedules, simply call the league director at 651-792-7105.

ROSTER SIZE LIMITS

Rosters are limited to a maximum of twenty (20) players for league play and post season Roseville play-off tournaments. ***Rosters must be submitted to league director prior to league start!***

Only the 20 players listed on the front of the roster form will be eligible to participate in MRPA/USSSA Regional and State post-season tournaments. Substitutes listed on the roster after the roster deadlines will not be eligible for MRPA/USSSA Tournaments.

MANAGERS MEETING

The managers meeting will be posted online and will consist of a short 15-min video reviewing important league information and rules.

LEAGUE SCHEDULES

All schedules will be posted/available online via: teamsideline.com/rpr. Managers will be contacted once schedules are available.

SOFTBALLS & MATERIALS

All teams will be provided with softballs (home games) and scorebooks- materials will be distributed during the first night of league play at your corresponding field.

PRACTICES

Registered teams may reserve fields for practices by contacting the league director at 651-792-7105. One field can be reserved up to one week in advance (week nights only). Practice field locations are the same as game fields listed below. Practice fields will be available (weather permitting) as of April 9, 2019. You may call to make reservations beginning Monday, March 25, 2019.

GAME FIELDS & LOCATIONS

League play begins Monday, April 22, 2019; games may be played on the following fields:

- Central Park Victoria Ball Fields (5 fields)
- Central Park Lexington Ball Fields (2 fields)
- B-Dale Villa Ball Fields (1 field)

MANAGERS' DUTIES:

1. Make sure you have a full team and at least one reserve for every game
2. You, the manager, must handle all disputes. Please do not let one of your players face ejection by arguing a call.
3. Responsible for taking charge of your team's and your spectator's conduct. Abusive language, drinking, littering and other irresponsible acts will not be tolerated.
4. Any schedule information, changes or other league information will be given to you. It is your responsibility to pass the information on to your players.
5. Understand the league rules. Tell your players the rules so the game can run smoothly
6. Gather and submit a complete roster to include full names, addresses (cities) and phone numbers of all members on your team.

FIRST AID

Teams are encouraged to supply a first aid kit for their team. Field supervisors will have a first aid kit, but may not always be present at your field when an injury occurs.

LEAGUE CLASSIFICATIONS

Summer/Fall Softball Leagues

C/Silver Level- Intended for teams seeking a highly competitive softball experience and participate in tournaments.

D/Bronze Level– Intended for recreation teams who desire a moderately competitive softball experience

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Sign up for the appropriate league of your choice (division and day). ***Returning teams who place top of their league are highly encouraged to move up a league, when applicable.***

All teams must submit the following to complete the registration process:

- Manager contact information (name, address, phone, DOB, etc.)
- Include a current email address for communication among the league director and team manager
- Team Name
- Full league fee: RPR accepts Visa, Master Card and American Express or please make checks payable to Roseville Parks and Recreation
