UPDATED PRESS RELEASE – FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The Ramsey County Medical Examiner’s Office has completed an autopsy on the body found on 3/22/2019 at Dale Street and Roselawn Avenue and confirmed it to be Ralph Latrez Bell, a 24 year old missing Stillwater man. The preliminary manner of death is suicide. The case is still under investigation and toxicology results are still pending.

Bell was reported missing on 12/20/18. His vehicle was found abandoned that same evening in the 800 block of Cope Avenue in Roseville, approximately an hour after he left his apartment in the 1600 block of Greeley Street, in Stillwater.

On 3/22/2019, Bell’s body was discovered on a vacant lot by a citizen looking for shed deer antlers. The Bureau of Criminal Apprehension assisted in processing the scene.
