Dear Property Manager,

For many years the City of Roseville has strived to be a leader in sustainability. In 2013 the City renegotiated their citywide residential recycling contract with Eureka Recycling. In 2014, the City began single sort recycling which expanded the materials that can be recycled. That tradition of progressive thinking continues today.

One of the new and innovative provisions included in the agreement is the voluntary inclusion of churches and small businesses into the City's residential recycling contract. For a small fee churches and small businesses can set up single sort recycling at their building. See the "Opt-In Form 2019" form for more information.

This partnership will help the City meet the recycling goals and will support local organizations in their mission to be more sustainable. Organizations may also see a substantial decrease in the amount of trash generated at their buildings saving them money on monthly hauling bills.
