On June 9, 2019 at 10:02 p.m., Roseville Police responded to 1681 Rice Street on a domestic related shooting that had just occurred in the parking lot. Officers located a 41 year-old male from Minneapolis in the parking lot with an apparent gunshot wound. The male was immediately transported to a local hospital for life-threatening injuries. He remains in critical condition.

A 40-year old female of St. Paul was taken into custody in the parking lot. A gun was recovered on scene. The female was ultimately booked at the Ramsey County Law Enforcement Center for attempted murder in the second degree ([Minn. Stat. § 609.19](#), [609.17](#)). Crime scene personnel from the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension assisted with processing the scene.

Detectives are continuing to investigate the events leading up to the shooting. At this time, there is no threat to the public and there is no indication that any additional suspects were involved. The case will ultimately be presented to the Ramsey County Attorney's Office for charging consideration.
