The Roseville Police Department is looking for help from the public with identifying two individuals who are responsible for two recent robberies in Roseville, Minnesota.

The first robbery occurred on July 27, 2019 at 1:00 A.M. at the Speedway located at 2380 County Road D. The male and female approached the counter to make a purchase. When the cashier opened the register to make change for their purchase, the male lunged across the counter, pushed the cashier back, and grabbed money from the register. The male and female immediately fled in a smaller silver vehicle.

The second robbery occurred on July 28, 2019 at 12:40 A.M. at the Speedway located at 2172 Lexington Avenue. Again, the male suspect reached across the counter and grabbed cash as soon as the cashier opened the register to make change for his purchase. He then ran out of the store. Based on witness descriptions and surveillance video, the male suspect is believed to be the same person involved in the robbery at the Speedway, located at 2380 County Road D.
