## **Suspect Arrested and Charged for 2017 Roseville Murder**

On October 30, 2019, a Ramsey County Grand Jury indicted Perry Earl Williams III, 33 of St. Paul, for his involvement in the homicide of Dondi Antwan Nalls, 35, of Roseville. Williams was arrested in Oakdale on October 31, 2019. He was charged with the following counts:

- Count 1 - Crime for gang benefit aiding and abetting first degree premeditated murder
- Count 2 - Aiding and abetting first degree premeditated murder
- Count 3 - Crime for gang benefit aiding and abetting second degree intentional murder
- Count 4 - Aiding and abetting second degree intentional murder

On September 23, 2017 at 5:25 p.m., Roseville Police responded to a shooting in the 1400 block of Terrace Drive. Officers located Mr. Nalls lying on the ground in front of an apartment complex, suffering from gunshot wounds. Officers attempted lifesaving measures, but Mr. Nalls was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The indictment and arrest follow a two-year investigation led by the Roseville Police Department, along with the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, St. Paul Police, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and the Ramsey County Attorney's Office.

This remains an active investigation. No additional information is available at this time.
