501.20: SPECIAL MULTIPLE DOG LICENSES:

Upon issuance of a special multiple dog license, three (3) or four (4) dogs over three (3) months of age may be kept at a licensed premises upon compliance with the following:

- A. Written Approval: The filing of written approval of the occupants from at least seventy five percent (75%) of the residential property abutting the licensed premises.
- B. Fenced Yard: The yard of the licensed premises is fenced in such a manner as to restrain dogs on the premises from leaving the yard.
- C. Nuisance: Dogs kept on the licensed premises do not create a nuisance by excessive barking or by creating unsanitary conditions.
- D. Fee: Payment of a yearly license fee pursuant to Section 301.03 of this Code.
- E. Denial of Application: The Chief of Police may deny requests for renewal of a special multiple dog license based upon complaints received during the preceding year. In the event of such a denial, the applicant may, within ten (10) days of being advised of the denial, request, in writing, a hearing before the City Council on the denial. (Ord. 1109, 4-13-92)
