Suspect charged in shooting

On April 24, 2020, Jahree Mashoun Walker, 18 of Roseville, was charged with two counts of 2nd degree assault for his involvement in a shooting that occurred on April 22, 2020.

On April 22, at 8:56 p.m., Roseville officers responded to a report of shots fired in the 2700 block of Rice Street. A few blocks away, Ramsey County deputies received a call of a female suffering from a gunshot wound to her back. The 21 year-old female was transported to a local hospital for non-life-threatening injuries.

Based on cell phone video and witnesses, officers learned there had been an altercation between 6 to 8 individuals in the parking lot. During the incident, two shots were fired as the groups fled in separate vehicles.

The suspect, Jahree Mashoun Walker, was arrested without incident at a nearby apartment.

Several search warrants were executed, including a search of Walker's apartment. Detectives located the pants he was wearing during the incident, which had a 9 mm cartridge in the pocket. Detectives recovered the gun used in the shooting in a nearby apartment.
