Program has been modified:

- Bowlers will follow social distancing practices including physically spacing bowlers during play.

Arrival and Departure Information:

- Upon checking in, please allow at least 6 feet of distance between bowlers.
- Please prescreen for COVID-19 symptoms and stay home if symptoms exist.

Spectator Information:

- Flaherty's Bowl has an occupancy level. We request spectators to not attend at this time.

Basic Cleaning Information:

- Flaherty's staff disinfect tables, bowling balls, rental shoes, etc consistently throughout the day.

Facial Covering Information:

Per Executive Order 20-81, face coverings are required in indoor facilities and will apply to Flaherty's employees as well as bowlers. **Bowlers must wear a face covering the duration of participating in bowling, including when they are actively bowling.**
