## **PROGRAM HAS BEEN MODIFIED:**

*For each session, Covid-19 conditions and program participation will be evaluated to determine whether the session will be offered in-person or online. Participants will be notified one week prior to start of each session.*

- Indoor activities will take place at 6' tables with one participant stationed at each end and tables arranged at least 6' apart. Adults will be expected to supervise their child-partners for distancing.
- Outdoor activities will have markers on the ground, 6' apart, for stationary activities; mobile activities will implement "Eagle Wings" method of spacing with outstretched arms.

## **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFORMATION:**

- Check-in will be at a table inside HANC entry doors (with 6' spots marked up to the outer doors and onto the pavement beyond).
- Participants will be asked if they have checked themselves for displayed Covid-19 symptoms.

## **SPECTATOR INFORMATION:**

## **BASIC CLEANING INFORMATION:**

- Daily cleaning and disinfecting of all high touch surfaces (counters, tabletops, chairs, door handles, chairs, program supplies.)
- Upstairs bathroom cleaning & disinfecting every morning by cleaning service.

## **FACIAL COVERING INFORMATION:**

Instructors AND participants are required to wear masks during the indoor part of the program. If the activity is being held outdoors, neither will be required to wear a mask.
