We cannot accommodate same day rentals. Pick up and drop off will be contactless and equipment will be disinfected between renters. Ski rentals and snowshoes are available for pick up M (8-noon), W (Noon-4), and F (noon-4). Return will be during the same time frames.



Minnesota's favorite winter pastime, outdoor skating, is back. Skating is available at Acorn, Autumn Grove, Lexington, Sandcastle, Mapleview (pleasure rink only) and Villa Parks through mid-February (weather permitting). Several parks have after-hours rink lights available. Warming houses may be reduced or unavailable due to COVID-19. We encourage all users to use our expanded outdoor seating and storage racks when at the rinks.

COVID-19 UPDATE

As the COVID-19 pandemic has worn on, the importance of recreational activities has been increasingly emphasized from both state and national health organizations as imperative to physical, mental and emotional health. Although some activities cannot be offered during the pandemic, we are committed to continuing to be innovative to provide recreational opportunities to the Roseville community as safely as possible.

All recreational programs have been modified to comply with the Minnesota Department of Health and Centers for Disease Control guidance for recreational programs. Modifications include physical distance, reduced group sizes, increased cleaning and sanitization, and more.

The COVID-19 pandemic is ever-changing and we are committed to adapting with it to ensure the safety of our staff, participants and community as a whole. At press time for this newsletter (mid-November), the area was experiencing a significant uptick in case count and additional restrictions. We are continuing to monitor the situation and make modifications as needed. Some programs listed in this brochure may be cancelled, delayed or modified. If you do not feel comfortable participating in organized recreation during this time, we offer numerous self-guided, individual activities this winter including cross country skiing, snowshoeing, more than 60 miles of maintained pathways, outdoor rinks and more.

DONATION ALLOWS FOR INCLUSIVE PLAY EXPANSION IN 2021

Parks and Recreation and the Friends of Roseville Parks (FOR Parks) are working to provide expanded inclusive opportunities for residents of all ages and abilities in Central Park next summer. The project aims to provide a more accessible, exciting and complete experience for users of all abilities. One component of the project aims to expand and enhance the existing playground at Central Park Victoria West including all chair-friendly surfacing, additional universally-designed play equipment and a modified layout to improve play experience for users of all abilities.

A second component of the project envisions adding several outdoor "fitness pods" in Central Park, which can be used to exercise by users of all ages while enjoying the park.



The city has received input from more than 130 Roseville residents, experts in inclusive play and individuals with disabilities on the proposed project.
