Project Scope

Project Scope & Goals

- Install 10 foot wide bituminous trail over RCD 4 pipe corridor
- Phase 1 Make connections between County Road C and Terrace Avenue
- Phase 2 Explore feasibility and get input on making connection to Oasis Park
- Create improved pedestrian crossing at Terrace Avenue
 - Crosswalk & signage
 - Possible pedestrian refuge or flashers
- Use Twin Lakes landscaping design standard
 - Install lighting
 - Install landscaping including trees
 - Install benches and way finding signage








Project Background

Ramsey County Ditch 4 Project

- Rice Creek Watershed (RCWD)
 maintains the current ditch
 - City will take over maintenance once pipe is installed
- With adjacent development occurring the City worked with RCWD to look into replacing pipe into a ditch
- Benefits
 - Reduces long-term maintenance
 - Reduces flooding up stream
 - Additional opportunities for trail and landscaping improvements


Twin Lakes Area Developments

- Fairview Avenue Addition (Area 1)
 - Tareen Dermatology
 - Medical office building
 - Isaac Apartments
 - 127 market rate apartments
- Twin Lakes Station Plat (Area 2)
 - Oasis at Twin Lakes Phase 1
 - 228 units apartments
 - Under construction
 - Oasis at Twin Lakes Phase 2
 - 277 senior living apartments
 - Commercial Development

Project Details

Project Funding

- ~\$3.3 million
 - RCWD Funding
 - Watershed Management Area (Assessments for the pipe project)
 - City Storm Sewer Funds
 - Adjacent Development Funds

Project Schedule

- Finalize Plans January
- Start Construction RCD 4 & Ditch early spring 2021
- Final Construction RCD 4 end of July
- Final construction of Twin Lakes Trail phase 1 September 2021
- Phase 2 Unknown at this time



Should the connection be made?

- Input from residents
- Connection shown in the 2018 pathway master plan

Feasibility

- Constructability
 - Can it be built?
- Easements
 - Trail easement likely required
- Cost
 - Are adequate funds available?


Proposed Pathway Segments (20.64 miles Existing Striped Shoulder (28.45 miles) Other (Boardwalk- 0.94 miles)

Timing

- If this phase moves forward, it would be likely done as a separate project from phase 1
- Could occur later this year if easements are acquired and if funds are available


