On 5/24/2019 at around 0240 hours, officers and paramedics were at Lexington Ave / Hwy 36 assisting an unrelated male with a medical issue. A male, later ID'd as mentioned party Jesse Werling (MN ID), exited a Blue and White cab on the eastbound Hwy 36 off ramp, and walked towards Officers. Werling deliberately walked to the crosswalk, and was preparing to cross towards us. We asked Werling to use the crosswalk on the other (west) side of the street, to protect the patients privacy and prevent any interference with our medical aid. Werling remained at the southeast corner of the intersection, apparently observing responders.

A short time later, Werling yelled something, and hurled a projectile towards responders. Officer Hicke and I detained Werling in handcuffs, believing he was attempting to assault us, the paramedics, or the patient. The object was discovered to be a wooden cutout of a pig, from a children's toy set. We determined through further conversation and LETG research that Werling had a history of mental health issues. Werling told officers he threw the item because he wasn't sure if the patient was being treated fairly by the police. Werling had been getting a cab ride home, but asked to be let out upon seeing emergency vehicles. Werling conceded he had no knowledge of the situation we were doing with, prevented responders from giving the patient proper care due to his actions, and made a poor decision.

I called Werling's father, who stated Werling had an appointment later in the day to address recent mental health symptoms. Werling's father agreed to come to the scene and bring Werling the rest of the way home. Based on the circumstances, I felt arresting Werling would be counterproductive to his situation. Werling was released to his father, and stated he understood the actions officers took after he threw the object, and the reasons why he was detained.

I issued the attached trespass notice to Werling, prohibiting him from being on the XXXXXXXX property. He stated the trespass form was illegal but confirmed he understood to stay off the property. XXXXXX will also look into obtaining an HRO through Ramsey County. BWC active.

On 6/6/19, I spoke to Ramsey County Mental Health regarding concerns with 2976 West Owasso. They advised that the adult son (Jesse) recently moved in with his father. His father reported to Ramsey County that his adult son is no longer taking his medication and the father has been trying to find alternative medical treatment to assist with his mental health issues. The father recognized his son needed help; however, most of his plans did not provide for any immediate care. The father is very skeptical of traditional Western medicine and has been seeking more holistic approaches to address his mental health and paranoia.

Ramsey County Mental Health attempted to make contact with the son (Jesse), but he refused to cooperate, noting he did not have adequate batteries to record the interaction on his recording devices.

Ramsey County Mental Health advised the house and yard were very run down, with overgrown vegetation, extremely cluttered, flies throughout the house, and overall in very poor condition. The son had been previously living in Stillwater, but recently started staying with his father because of

problems and run ins with his neighbors in Stillwater.

Jesse has a long history of police contacts with Stillwater Police. Stillwater reported they have responded to a number of disturbance, harassment, and mental health related calls with Jesse.

Ramsey County Mental Health requested to be notified if we respond to any additional calls or if a transport hold is placed on Jesse. In 2018, he was under commitment orders for six months, however, he no longer has any mandated case management.

I forwarded info to Code regarding the property issues. They will be following up.

I also flagged the property with dispatch for mandatory comments and officer safety.

On 6/8/19 at 1402 hours, I was dispatched to XXXX XXXX XXXXXX XXXXXXXX on a disorderly conduct call. Dispatch informed the complainant's neighbor, Jesse, was in the bushes recording their graduation party. Dispatch updated that Jesse many have mental health issues.

I recalled CN 19017793 in roll call regarding Jesse Henri Werling. Ramsey County Mental Health requested to be notified of any contacts and was willing to sign a transport hold if needed. Jesse has a history of mental health issues and was possibly bi-polar.

I called the complainant and learned she did not see Jesse in the bushes. She was told by a male who was walking the neighborhood handing out flyers about the person in the bushes. The male told her the person in the bushes had a camera and was recording them. She immediately believed this was Jesse as he has done similar things like this several times in the past.

I contacted Jesse's father, Henry John Werling, and told him what had occurred. Henry asked me not

to contact Jesse as he was afraid that would only make the matter worse. He stated he was in Stillwater but would return home to get Jesse and bring him somewhere else.

The complainant did not wish for officers to respond to her residence as they were hosting a graduation party.

On 6/9/19 at 1146 hours, squads were dispatched to 2976 West Owasso Boulevard on a person in crisis. Dispatch informed the complainant's neighbor, Jesse Werling, was following and taking pictures of the complainant's family this morning. Werling was also running around with his pants down exposing himself to the kids.

I was aware of the mental health and aggression alerts on Werling and knew that Ramsey County Mental Health requested to be contacted if there were further contacts with him.

Officer K. Johson and I spoke to the complainant, XXXX XXXXX XXXXXX, who informed us of the following. His wife, XXXXX XXXXX XXXXXXX, alerted him that while in their backyard, she saw Jesse walk from his (Jesse's) porch into the house (Jesse's) with his pants down around his knees. Jesse's genitals were exposed as he causally walked inside.

I spoke to XXXXX and she reiterated what XXXX told me. XXXXX was upset as her friend, XXXXX XXXXXXXX XXXXXXX, and XXXXXXXXX 3 and 5 year old (XXXXXX and XXXX) were present and saw Jesse naked. She believed Jesse intentionally did this as they had been in the backyard for a period of time and saw Jesse walking around on his side of the property.

XXXXX stated Jesse has a history of spying on them and would try to secretly take pictures of her family and guests.

Officer K. Johnson contacted Ramsey County Mental Health and spoke to XXXXX who informed she would respond to place a hold on Jesse.

I called Jesse's father, Henry John Werling, who agreed to return home from Stillwater. He asked that Jesse be taken to a hospital.

I had Henry go get Jesse from inside the house and we spoke to him on the front yard.

Jesse was in manic state and accused everyone of ganging up to get him. Jesse went on to say the neighbors were conspiring against him and was making up stories about him walking around naked to get him in trouble. Jesse continued on and said we were violating his civil rights, demanded a lawyer, and refused to go to the hospital.

Officer K. Johnson was able to de-escalate Jesse after several minutes of reasoning with him. Jesse finally agreed to go to the hospital with Allina.

Allina transported Jesse to St. Joe's on XXXXXXX transport hold.

My BWC was activated during the contact.

***WOULD LIKE TO SPEAK TO OFFICERS IN PERSON** COMP BELIEVES HIS DEVICES ARE BEING HACKED DUE TO PEOPLE MAKING REFERENCES ABOUT THINGS THAT HE HAS SAVED ON HIS DEVICES....WOULD LIKE TO SPEAK TO OFFICERS ABOUT THAT..... PREM HX SHOWS HX OF MH CALLS.

I made contact over the phone with verbally identified Achilles Elizabeth who I later identified through previous contacts as Jesse Werling. He informed me the government was hacking multiple devices in his work space and stealing his identity. He continued to rant about his distrust in the government and how he doesn't even know what year he was born. Werling advised his life was in danger because of this and that thousands of over lives were also in danger and people were dying.

I contacted Ramsey County Adult Crisis and informed them of Werling's situation and advised them to reach out to him. They informed me they were familiar with Werling and he often calls himself Queen Elizabeth.
