RE: Villa Park: Sediment Pond Improvements 2022-23

Dear Resident:

The City of Roseville will be making stormwater improvements and performing maintenance of Sediment Pond within Villa Park during the winter of 2022-23. Sediment Pond is the northernmost pond, closest to the B-Dale Club and County Road B. Maintenance of the pond will include:

- Dewatering of the pond
- Removing and replacing the concrete outlet structure
- Stabilization of the inlets and outlets
- Minor tree removal around the pond near the inlets and outlets
- Dredging of pond sediment

During this work, pathways in the park will remain open as much as possible, but there may be sections that are not accessible at all times. Signage will be in place to direct park users around the construction activity.

To prepare for this winter work, the City will be trapping turtles in Sediment Pond and relocating them to the wetland cells to the south. Traps will be set starting Monday, August 8, and will be checked daily throughout August and into fall. The traps will be baited Monday through Friday each week, but they will not be set out over the weekends. By trapping the turtles, we can relocate them to a safe location where they can burrow and hibernate over winter.
